



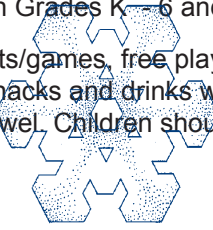
HK Recreation February Break Days

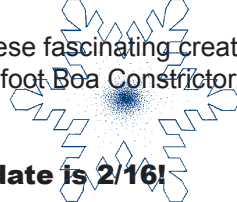


Schedule of activities:
