

HK Recreation All Day Child Care

The HK Recreation Department will be offering an all-day child care program at the HK High School Cafeteria. The program will provide care for children entering first through eighth grades. The program will meet from 7:00 am until 6:00 pm. The program activities are both active and passive in nature. Types of activities offered include: Arts & Crafts, Sports/Games, Free Play and Swimming in the HK HS Pool. There is a late pick-up fee of \$5 for every 5 minutes a parent is late past 6:00 pm, paid directly to the program staff on the day of late pick-up.

Swimming: Campers will have a choice to go swimming at the HK pool from 1:00 – 3:00 pm. Lifeguards will be on duty along with camp staff. Alternate activities will be offered to non-swimmers.

Ice Cream Truck: The ice cream truck will be coming to camp after lunch. Please send your child with no more than \$3.00 for ice cream.

What to bring: Children should bring a bag lunch. AM and PM snacks will be provided. Anyone swimming should bring a bathing suit and towel. Children should wear sneakers and dress for active play.
